## Identifying Coins and Skip Counting Explain – Answer Key

## Materials:

- 100 charts (Explain Activity Sheet or kept from Explore Activity Sheet)
- 1 color of transparent counters (students need to be able to see numbers below counters)

## Procedure:

- 1. Tell students this is a 100 chart. Have the students look at the chart and say why it is names a 100 chart.
- 2. Ask students to cover the counting by 10 numbers with their blue counters.
- 3. What do you notice about these numbers
- 4. Ask them which of these number are counting by ten numbers:
  - a. 18
  - b. 60
  - c. 31
  - d. 100
- 5. Ask the students if they can recognize a counting by 10 number without looking at their shaded 100 chart.
- 6. Have students complete the Explain Activity Sheet.
